

FIRE/EMS, POLICE, STREET, WATER, WATER RECLAMATION, & LIBRARY

Our residents and businesses have many services available to them. These include Fire, Police, Street, Water and Water Reclamation services. We are also very proud of our Library and two Parks. Our new Municipal Complex located at 934 W. Main Street combines the Administration office, Council Chambers, Police Dept. and the Library.



FIRE & EMS

The Hebron Fire Department proudly protects approximately 7,000 people in both the Village of Hebron and Union Township. Our response area covers one of the largest Industrial Complexes in the State of Ohio, ranging from warehouses to chemical plants, with a thriving growth in residential subdivisions. The Firehouse is located at 111 Basin Street. Hebron is a member of the Licking County 911 emergency system. The non emergency number is 740-928-4721.



POLICE & MAYOR'S COURT

Our Police Department is a CALEA certified department that offers 24 hr protection, criminal investigation, traffic control, a community response team and bike patrol. Our Mayor's Court is conducted by a magistrate on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday's of every month in Council Chambers. Hebron is a member of the Licking County 911 emergency system which allows quick, easy response to emergency situations. The non-emergency number is 740-928-9402.



STREET

Our Street Department offers the following services; repairs to road surface, storm water maintenance, mosquito abatement, mowing, sign maintenance, snow plowing, Parks and cemetery maintenance. The Street Department is located at 112 Elm Street and the phone number is 740-928-1778.



WATER TREATMENT FACILITY

The Water Treatment Facility was built in the 1930's and supplies water to 760 customers which include the Newar Industrial Park. The Plant was expanded in 2004 and now can process 2.16 million gallons per day (MGD). The Water Treatment Facility is located at 415 S. High Street and the phone number is 740-928-8792.



WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY

The Wastewater facility was built in 1964 and was expanded in 2007 to meet the rising growth of our community. The facility now reclaims 1.5 million gallons a day and 5 million peak flow and is located at 3261 Hebron Road and the phone number is 928-8793.



LIBRARY



PARKS




EVANS PARK

In 1992 the T J Evans Foundation purchased thirty acres for the Village to develop and in 1995 forty-two more acres were added. This park is located at the center of town with a large shelter house and gazebo it makes a great place to have family outings. It's equipped with playgrounds and large open area and softball fields.




